



Parking Passes

- Mandatory Parking Fee of \$300.00 per team (unlimited number of vehicles).
- Order Online. Your team will be sanctioned if the team pass is not purchased.
- No need to print passes.

SMS Notifications & Weather

- Scan the QR code using the WhatsApp camera to receive weather, field, and schedule notifications
- The Event Team will be constantly monitoring weather conditions and will follow any local requirements as well as established US Youth Soccer weather protocols
- Barboursville: Airhorns will be used to notify play has been suspended
- Shawnee: Complex announcement system will be used to notify play has ben suspended.
- Take shelter in your cars and wait for further notifications

USYS Member Passes & Rosters

- Everyone in the bench area (all players, coaches, managers, trainers, etc.) must have a current seasonal year USYS/State Association laminated member pass with recent photo
- All Team Officials must have a valid USYS/State Association laminated pass AND bench pass to be allowed in the technical area during matches; See Bench Pass Restrictions
- Passes should be on a ring in alphabetical order. Players first followed by Team officials
- Players not on the locked event roster in GotSport will not be permitted to play
- Note: newer machine-printed plastic passes are ok

- GotSport is the USYS official event management system
- Online Check-In Process due Friday June 7th
- Upload PDF files for:
- Upload PDF files for:
 - Primary (P),Club Pass (CP) and Team Official Passes as (1) PDF document
 - Additional Rostered (ARP) Player Passes as (1) PDF document
 - Do not include players that are not participating
- We want to ensure ALL players and team officials are eligible prior to the event




Travel Commitment & Code of Conduct

- Eastern Presidents Cup Travel Commitment & Code of Conduct
- To be completed by a team official by 12:00 PM Monday June 10th
- Should your team qualify to advance to this year's National Presidents Cup, you will need to indicate your team's commitment to travel and participate: Your team AGREES or DECLINES to travel and compete in the National Presidents Cup
- This year the following teams will advance:
 - 13U-18U: BOTH CHAMPION & FINALIST
 - 19U: CHAMPION ONLY

Bench Area Restrictions

- A maximum of four (4) personnel will be permitted in the technical area during a match, including:
 - Coaches
 - Managers
 - Team Trainers
 - Other Team Officials
- Each person MUST also have both of the following:
 - A valid USYS/State Association laminated member pass
 - BENCH PASS credential visible at all times while in the technical area
 - Bench passes must be picked up at the venue's HQ Tent one hour before your first match



Uniform Requirements

- Each team must have two (2) uniform sets, including socks (one light color & one dark color) at each match during the competition
- Home team wears light colored jersey & socks; Away team wears dark colored jersey & socks
- If there is a jersey or sock color conflict, the team causing the conflict must change. The referee's decision is final.
- Uniform numbers must be permanently affixed to the back of jerseys and duplicate and/or taped numbers are prohibited
- Jersey numbers MUST be entered into the Got Sport regional roster
- A name, logo, or other identifying mark of any other youth soccer organization must be removed, replaced or covered (tape will not be accepted). USYS has semi-permanent patches available (\$3 each or \$75 for 44 patches, cash only, no checks or credit cards). Available at Event Headquarters.
- See Rule 210 for all uniform requirements

Match Procedures

- Each referee crew will be provided with your match card prior to your game
- International Walkout before each match
- Any ineligible players/coaches will be stricken through on the match card
- Each referee crew is responsible for reporting scores and submitting the completed match card
- If there is a score or goal scorer discrepancy, it must be communicated by a credentialed coach or team official at HQ

Odd Number Brackets



Despite all efforts to find replacements, late withdrawals have left no option but to utilize odd number brackets.

3-Team Bracket | One Group of 3

Teams play a round robin to determine standings. Group winner and runner-up advance to a final.

Day 1	Day 2	Day 3
A1 vs A2	A3 vs A1	A2 vs A3
A3 Bye	A2 Bye	A1 Bye

7-Team Bracket | One Group of 4 and One Group of 3

Each group plays a round robin to determine standings. Teams in the group of three (3) will have a day where no match is played. Group winners and two (2) Wildcards (the next two (2) highest point totals regardless of group) advance to the semifinal round. Semifinal pairings are Group A Winner vs. Higher Point Wildcard and Group B Winner vs Lower Point Wildcard. *If and only if* the Higher Point Wildcard is from Group A dependence of the semifinals are modified to Group A Winner vs. Lower Point Wildcard and Group B Winner vs. Higher Point Wildcard.

Note: For teams that play two (2) group matches, the average number of points earned from those two (2) matches will be added to their point total for purposes of determining advancement.

Cautions & Ejections

- There is no accumulation of cautions from match to match during the competition.
- A player or team official who is removed from any Eastern Presidents Cup game shall be automatically suspended in the team's next match.
- The Eastern Presidents Cup Event Team will review all such dismissals and additional penalties, or suspensions may be imposed.
- Ejected players may continue to set in the technical/bench area unless removed by the referee for inappropriate behavior after they have been ejected. If removed from the bench, the player must be accompanied by a credentialed Team Official. An ejected Coach must leave sight and sound of the field.
- See Rule 201 for discipline

Discriminatory Language/Actions

- US Youth Soccer rejects any form of discrimination, harassment or epithets directed towards an individual based on race, color, gender, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, age or physical/mental disability.
- If a Referee *hears* an epithet by a Player or Team Official:
 - an Ejection (Red Card) will result.
- If an epithet is *reported* to a Referee by a Player or Team Official:
 - A meeting on the Player's side of the field will take place.
 - Coaches will be permitted to inform their team that any further incidents may result in an immediate ejection, a temporary suspension of the match, the match being abandoned and/or teams being removed from the competition. For a match that is not resumed, the score when the match was stopped will stand.

Discriminatory Language/Actions by Spectators

- If an epithet by a Spectator is *heard by* or *reported to* a Referee:
 - The match will be stopped, and players directed to their benches.
 - Both Head Coaches will be advised of what was heard/reported.
 - Coaches will be requested to inform their spectators that any further incidents could result in a temporary suspension of the match, removal of all spectators from the match, the match being abandoned and/or teams being removed from the competition. For a match that is not resumed, the score when the match was stopped will stand.
 - The Head Coach may ask their spectators to help identify any offending spectator(s).
 - If the spectator is identified, they will be asked to leave. If they do not comply, Security will intervene.
 - Additionally, all spectators from the offending team may be removed for the balance of the match and/or future matches.


Referees

- Referees have also earned their place based on recommendations and accomplishments from within their state
- Alongside your teams, referees compete to earn the honor of attending the National Presidents Cup based on their performance
- Referees are supported by referee mentors who contribute to their development by guiding them in post-match reflections
- Presidents Cup WILL NOT tolerate ANY referee abuse and WILL NOT hesitate to clear the sidelines



Certified Athletic Trainers

- Trainers will be available for preventative taping services; Players must provide their own tape
- All medical injuries have priority
- The event Trainers are considered primary and any team or club trainers are secondary
- See Team Information Guide for hospital and urgent care facility listings



USYS Concussion Protocol

- If a player receives a completed USYS Concussion Form due to displaying signs and symptoms of a concussion, that player may not return to play until a signed clearance form from a medical doctor or doctor of osteopath who specializes in concussion treatment and management has been received
 - For clarification, whether an M.D. or D.O., the physician must specialize in concussion treatment and management.
- The event Trainers are considered primary, and any team or club trainers are secondary

Championship Matches

- Immediately following your championship match, BOTH teams MUST make their way to the awards area
- A representative of the following teams MUST pick up their National Presidents Cup Team Information Packet:
 - 13U-18U: BOTH CHAMPION & FINALIST
 - 19U: CHAMPION ONLY

Team Video Information

- Teams and Spectators may use their own recording devices within their spectator area, which is directly across from their team bench.
- Tripods and other supporting equipment MUST be securely staked down behind their own spectators.
- **Drones are not permitted.**
- VEO or similar Cameras must be placed a minimum of 3 yards into the spectator area from the half line and behind their own spectators.
